We thank you for the measure of peace that there has been in Northern Ireland and we ask that violence may not start up again as debates about the border are raised again.

We pray that as control over law making is taken back by Parliament that there will be new safeguards put in place so that we can continue to preach the Gospel and have liberty to declare the whole counsel of God.

We pray for our church in Hounslow West and ask that as we begin to meet again that we will have opportunities in the future to evangelise and that many will come to know the Lord. We pray for the elders that you will guide us as we reflect on our activities over the coming months.

Again our God we pray for those who are recovering from illness, we remember those who will still have to remain at home once we open the church again. We pray for those whose families live overseas and are unable to be united as a family. We pray for those whose lives would be at risk if they were to return to their own country, Lord be with them as they are unable to meet with their families. Lord in mercy hear our prayers for Christ the Saviour's sake.
